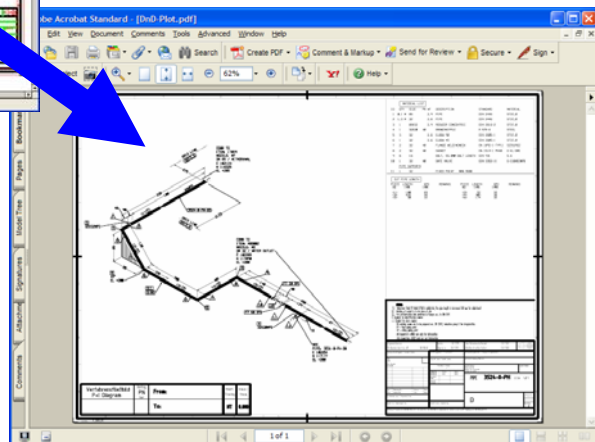
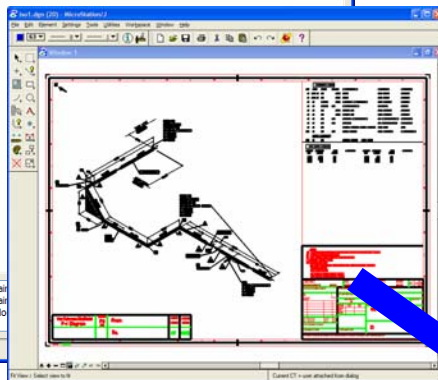
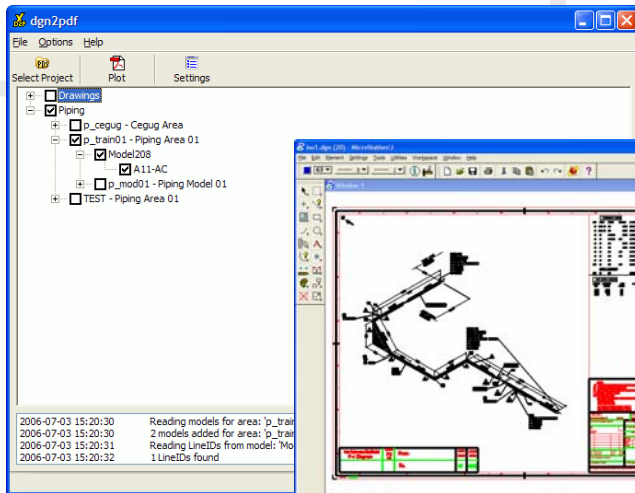
dgn2pdf

dgn2pdf is a fast PDF converter for MicroStation® DGN files. It processes single DGN files as well as complete directories packed with hundreds of DGN files or even ISO files and drawings selected from a PDS® project. The software features a powerful Graphical User Interface (GUI) for the configuration of the PDF output. Page formats, individual headlines and watermarks can be easily selected. Additionally, all settings can be saved and restored. All PDF files are generated without any additional PDF software or printer driver and are fully compliant with the PDF standard. dgn2pdf is the ideal tool for future-proof archival and easy exchange of plans and drawings. Its outstanding performance, the compactness and clearness of the PDF files produced (dgn2pdf generates true vector lines, not just a fuzzy screenshot of the drawing) make dgn2pdf a useful companion for PDS and MicroStation users.



Dgn2pdf

When working with PDS projects, dgn2pdf reads the structure of the PDS project into a clearly arranged tree view. ISO files and drawings (and their parent folders) can be selected by ticking the checkboxes in front of them. A click on 'Plot' brings up the PDF settings menu, 'OK' starts the output to PDF. Within a very short period of time a PDF file has been produced, which can be displayed by any PDF reader and easily used for reports and email messages.
